#### **About the Speakers:**

**Dr Carl Peters** MBCHB, FRACP is an Endocrinologist at Waitemata District Health Board, with a special interest in diabetes. After training in New Zealand, he moved to the UK to work as a clinician and clinical researcher at the Institute for Cellular Medicine, Newcastle University. His research work has focused on diabetes.

**Dr Ben Wheeler** MBCHB, DCH, CCE, FRACP, PhD is a Paediatric Endocrinologist and Associate Professor working with the Southern District Health board and University of Otago. His current research spans paediatric and adult age ranges, and is primarily focused on closed loop therapy in type 1 diabetes, as well as various applications of continuous glucose monitoring. This research is very collaborative with principal investigators, co-investigators, and participants variably based out of many New Zealand sites.

**Dr Craig Jeffries** MBCHB, Dip Paeds, FRACP, MD, PG Dip Bus is a Paediatric Endocrinologist based in Auckland. He has been in clinical practice since 2004, completing fellowship in Paediatric Endocrinology in Auckland and Toronto 1999-2004. His interests are in diabetes and acute complications, insulin therapy and monitoring.
